

Greetings.

Please let me advise you all that the Fitzroy Falls weekend has now been booked. Come and join us for the last of autumn in this scenic location.

The meeting of the weekend has been changed to a week later. It is from May the 5th to May the 7th, 2017.

In terms of a theme for the weekend we decided over a couple of meetings at the K Centre that we wouldn't have one because we felt that we will, as individuals, be in a new creative moment when we meet, so why tyrannise ourselves by pitting ourselves against a subject that may have no relevance to us come May.

Depending on our numbers we would be housed in several large dormitories that would house three to four people. Cost \$170 for two nights. There are only two single rooms with double beds. Cost \$350. The price includes three meals, plus morning and afternoon tea. Vegetarian, with special dietary needs able to be catered for to a degree, certainly vegan and gluten free. Bring your own specific supplements.

Attendees are required to bring their own sheets/blankets/quilts/sleeping bags. The Conference Centre only provides a fitted sheet and one pillowcase per bed. Between the 5th and the 7th May, at least at that time of the year, the weather is generally between 8 to 18 degrees, sunny-cloudy, with possible light showers so attendees should dress appropriately especially if bushwalking.

Payment would be required to be forwarded to the Krishnamurti Centre in Summer Hill's bank account. A cheque could then be drawn to reach The Conference Centre by the 21st of April, as they have requested.

Payment of \$170 to BSB 062257, Account No. 10220291. Full payment to be made by Wednesday the 19th of April.

Last year the hospitality was just amazing. The Conference Centre is located in a beautiful environment with water falls and walks both nearby, as well as on 40 acres of expansive property. The Conference Centre is 145kms south west of Sydney. Moss Vale, the nearest railway station, is a little over two hours from Sydney by either Country link or City Link trains, and one and

three quarter hours by car. Car-pooling may be able to be arranged if required. Pick up can also be arranged from Moss Vale train station around 2.30pm. Last year the Explorer train (a little dearer and slightly faster, this is a booked train) arrived at 1.54pm while the City Link train arrived at 2.13pm. See: (<http://www.sydneytrains.info> or google explorer train). The info. for May was unavailable when I just attempted to confirm those times but I suspect the timetable is unchanged.

I leave the most important detail in writing to you all until last.

Last year I think we only attracted about 13 or 14 people to the event, which, although it was a very rewarding meet, was due in no small part to a decision to hold the weekend at very short notice. From memory I think the notice of the event was only three or four weeks. At that time we boosted a Facebook post ad about the weekend and a notice was placed on the K Aust. website, however there was the inescapable feeling that, had we given earlier notice and utilised more advertising opportunities, we would most likely have attracted greater numbers.

I'm sending this email to at least thirty people comprised of those nearly made it or made it to the weekend at Fitzroy last year, as well as some others who've come to mind just now involved in working the teachings in their own lives. No doubt you'd all know far more people who would be interested in coming along to such as event.

What I'm earnestly asking of each of you is to circulate news of this upcoming event in anyway you can in your respective networks, such as via the phone, the Net, social media, even advertising etc. If there is a reasonable cost to meet advertising well we have some monies at The Centre that can be made available for this purpose.

This weekend is both an opportunity to meet and to enjoy downtime in a truly lovely and fairly remote location.

With three months or so as a lead time folk can plan and diarise.
